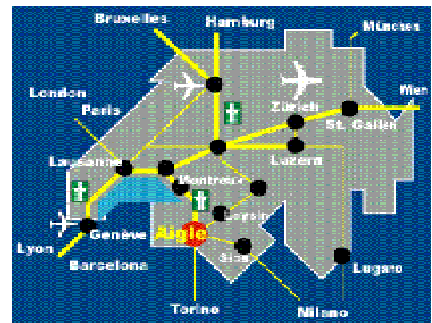
Car :

Follow the freeway A1 from Zürich to Berne, then follow A12 from Berne to Montreux and finally A9 from Montreux to Aigle.
